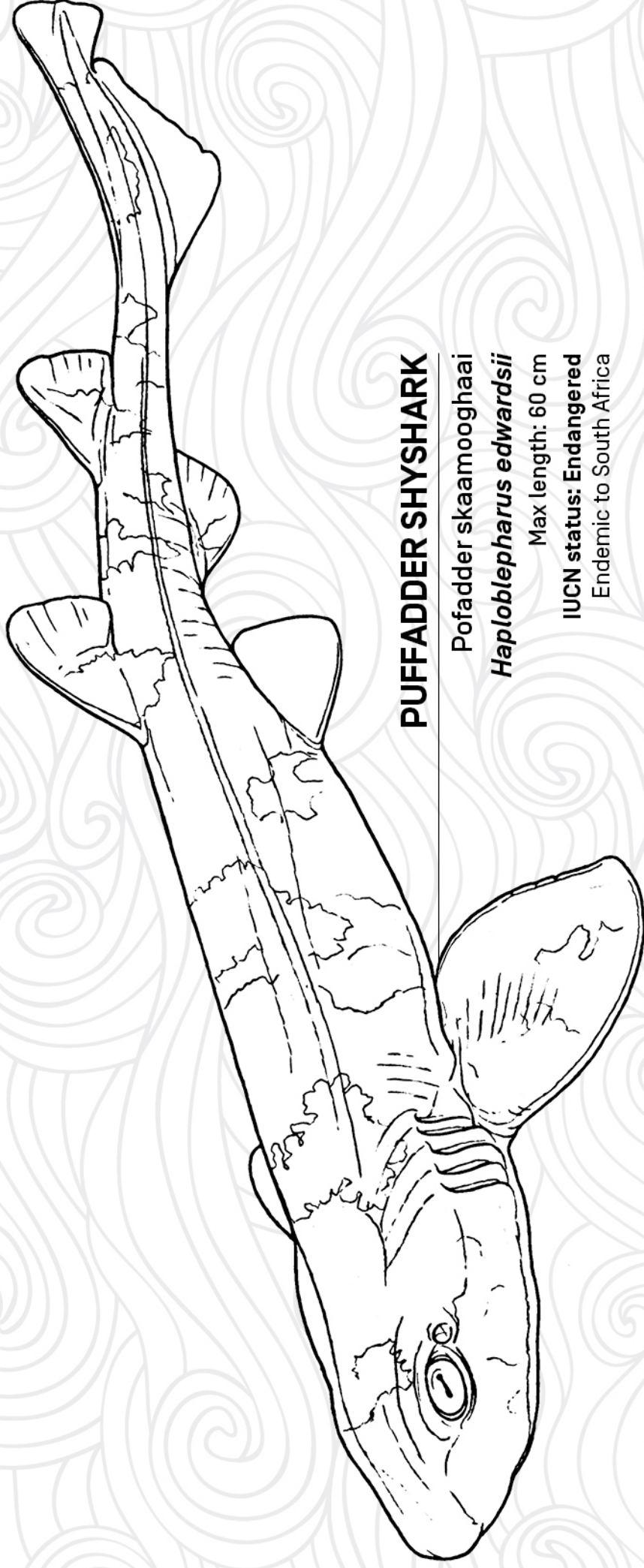


SHARKS OF FALSE BAY:

Pofadder skaamooghaai

Haploblepharus edwardsii

Max length: 60 cm

IUCN status: Endangered
Endemic to South Africa

This shark is one of the 13 most common species found in False Bay, South Africa. The International Union for Conservation of Nature's (IUCN) Red List of Threatened Species (www.iucnredlist.org) indicates the global conservation status of a species.

In this colouring series, species are listed as having either a wide distribution or being endemic to Africa (which means the species is only found there).
